Improve/Recommend

I believe, as with any course, whether on-line or on campus should have an instructor who teaches us something about the subject matter that isn't included in our textbook, sharing their perspective. A professor should be able to apply the concepts we're learning in class into situations relevant to us in order to help us can understand the subject more deeply. Otherwise, we're just taking a self study course by reading the text, answering the questions, and taking the final exam.

I don't think there should be so many conference questions to answer at once. We students only have so much time to read these chapters and most of us are enrolled in more than one class. With multiple questions to answer, one starts to cram, and when that happens, you don't always do your best work because you are focusing more on getting it done on time rather than the quality. I think it would be more beneficial to have to answer no more than two questions for each conference. Plus, requiring a response to your peers for every question is also very time consuming. Requiring a response to one question would also be more beneficial.

It would have helped if we could have had better feedback with writing our term papers such as a schedule or study group rather than just an ambiguous topic and due date.

Make the students correct their spelling and grammar before submitting work. I found it difficult to understand what some were trying to say because I couldn't read and make sense of what they had written.
